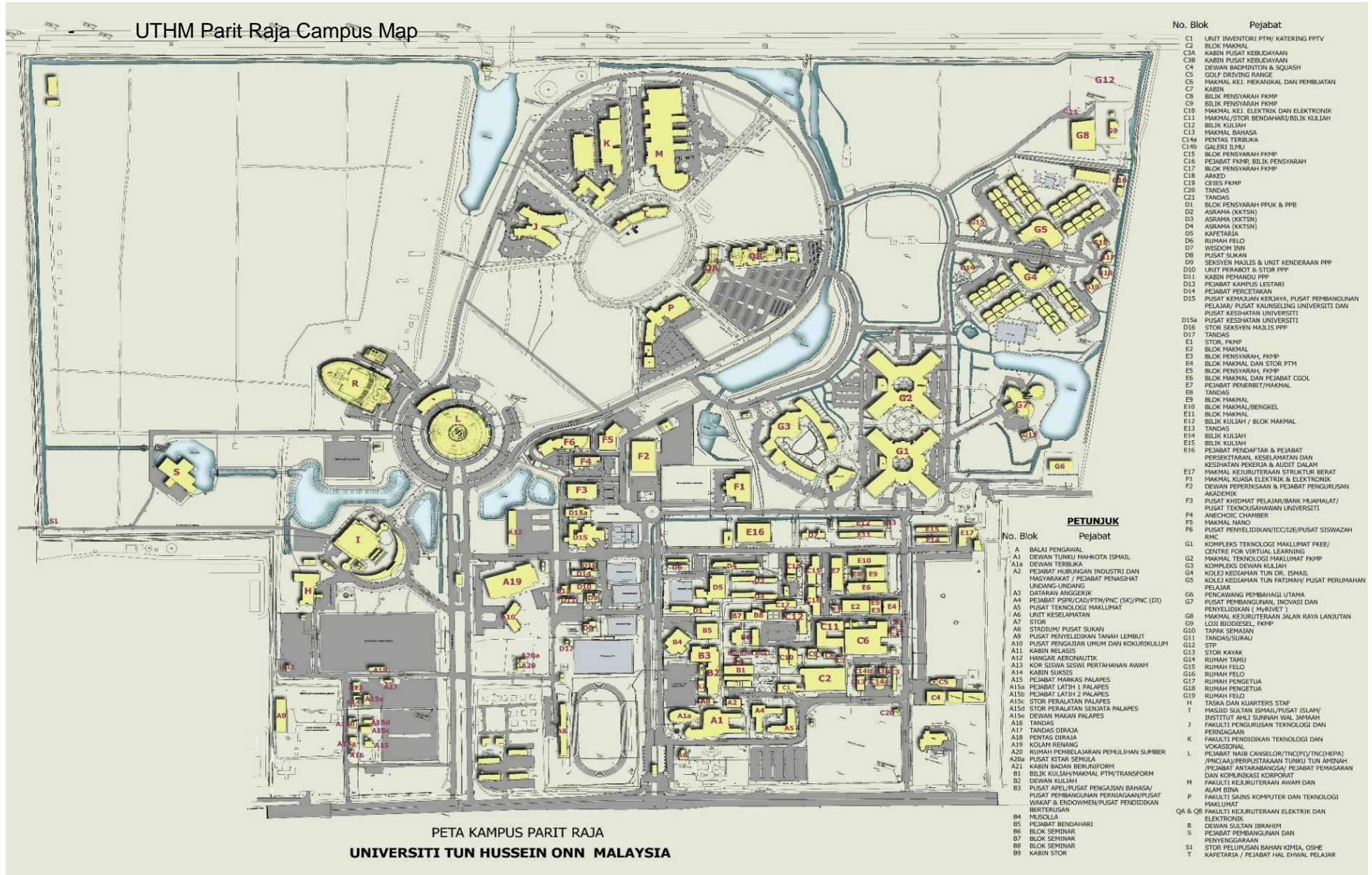

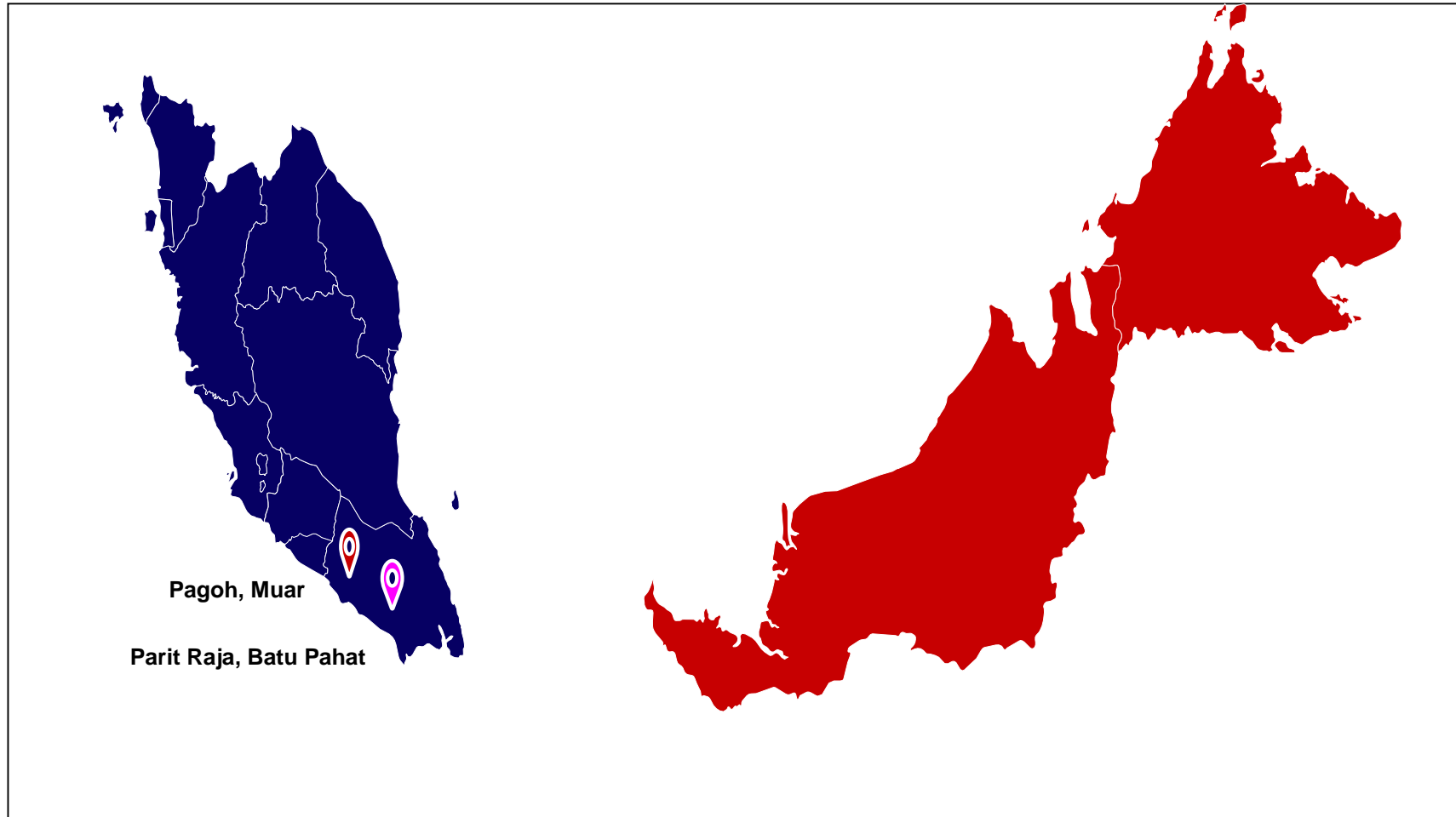

CHAPTER 2: PRE-ARRIVAL & ARRIVAL PREPARATION

2.1 Pre-Arrival Preparation Checklist

Depending on your flight carrier, you may arrive at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA)/ Kuala Lumpur International Airport 2 (KLIA2) terminal. On arrival at KLIA/ KLIA2, please take note of the following:


➤ Disembarkation Card

Complete a disembarkation card and hand it to the immigration officer with your passport and visa.

➤ Declaration and Prohibited Items

Under the provision of the Customs Act 1967, travellers entering Malaysia are required to declare all dutiable or prohibited goods in their possession. Failure to declare dutiable or prohibited goods or making a false declaration is an offence.

After completing the immigration procedure, please note the Malaysia immigration stamp on your passport. The stamp will indicate the last date of allowed stay in Malaysia. You must submit your passport to the International Office two weeks before the last date (expiry date) of the stamp in your passport. You may have to pay extra charges for processing your student pass if you cannot submit the passport on time. For further information:

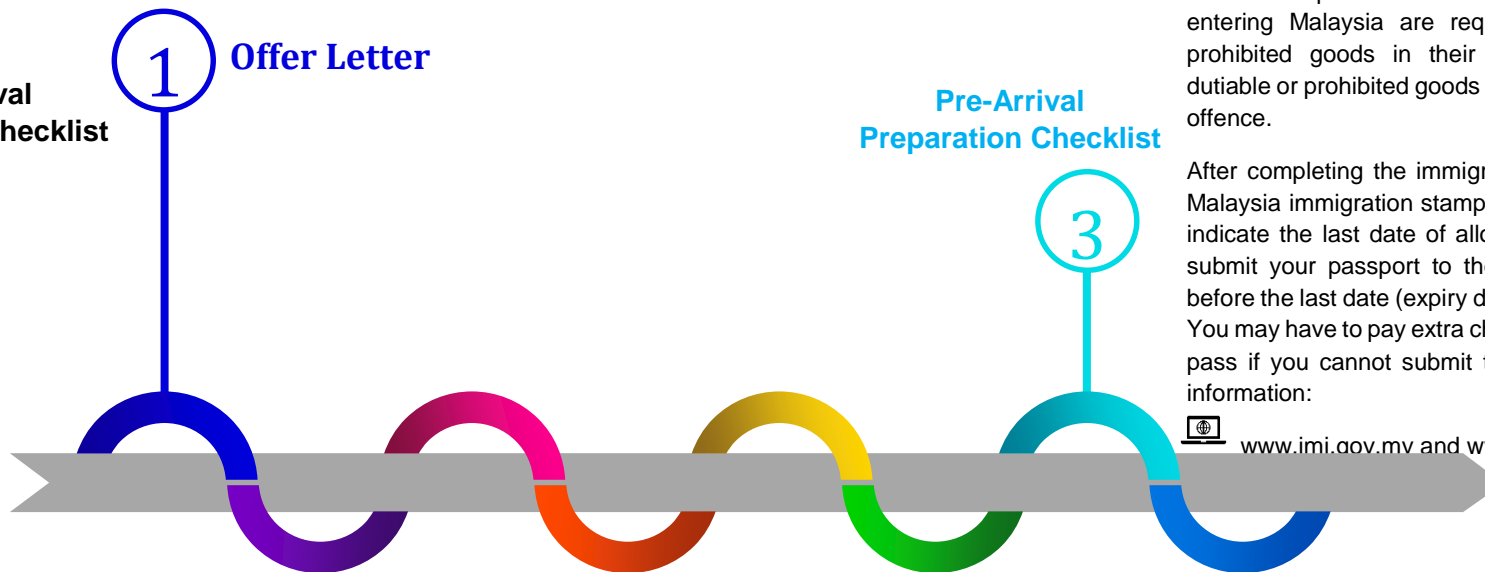

e-VAL (Visa)

All international applicants must apply for the Visa Approval Letter (VAL) before entering Malaysia. The Immigration Department Headquarters in Malaysia approve the visa. VAL is a visa issued by the Malaysia Representative Office abroad to a non-citizen to enable individuals to enter Malaysia legally. You must **not** enter Malaysia before the VAL is issued to you:

For new students:

- Please make sure that all your application is made through EMGS by online application.

- The VAL process may take 30-60 days

For existing students (already in Malaysia):

- Students who defer their studies must obtain VAL before re-entry to Malaysia.

- If your pass expired when you are in your home country, for MORE THAN 1 year.

#1. Pre-Departure

1. Register your name with UTHM at bit.ly/returnuthm
2. Obtain flight itinerary to match the proposed travel date in #1 to be used in #3. (Do not purchase flight ticket prior to Travel Authorisation (TA) approval)
3. Apply TA approval online at <https://visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my/guidelines/travel-authorisation-form-base.html>
4. Email documents (TA Approval Letter, [LOU form](#), flight ticket, Passport copy, Latest visa page) to the nearest Malaysian embassy to obtain Permission Letter to enter Malaysia.
5. Undergo PCR COVID-19 swap test within 3 days prior to the departure.
6. New student Existing student with visa expired need to apply for Single Entry Visa prior to departure.
7. Print hardcopy and fly with all the approval letters, COVID results and related travel documents (e.g. eVAL/ SEV/ Student Pass)

#2. Arrival

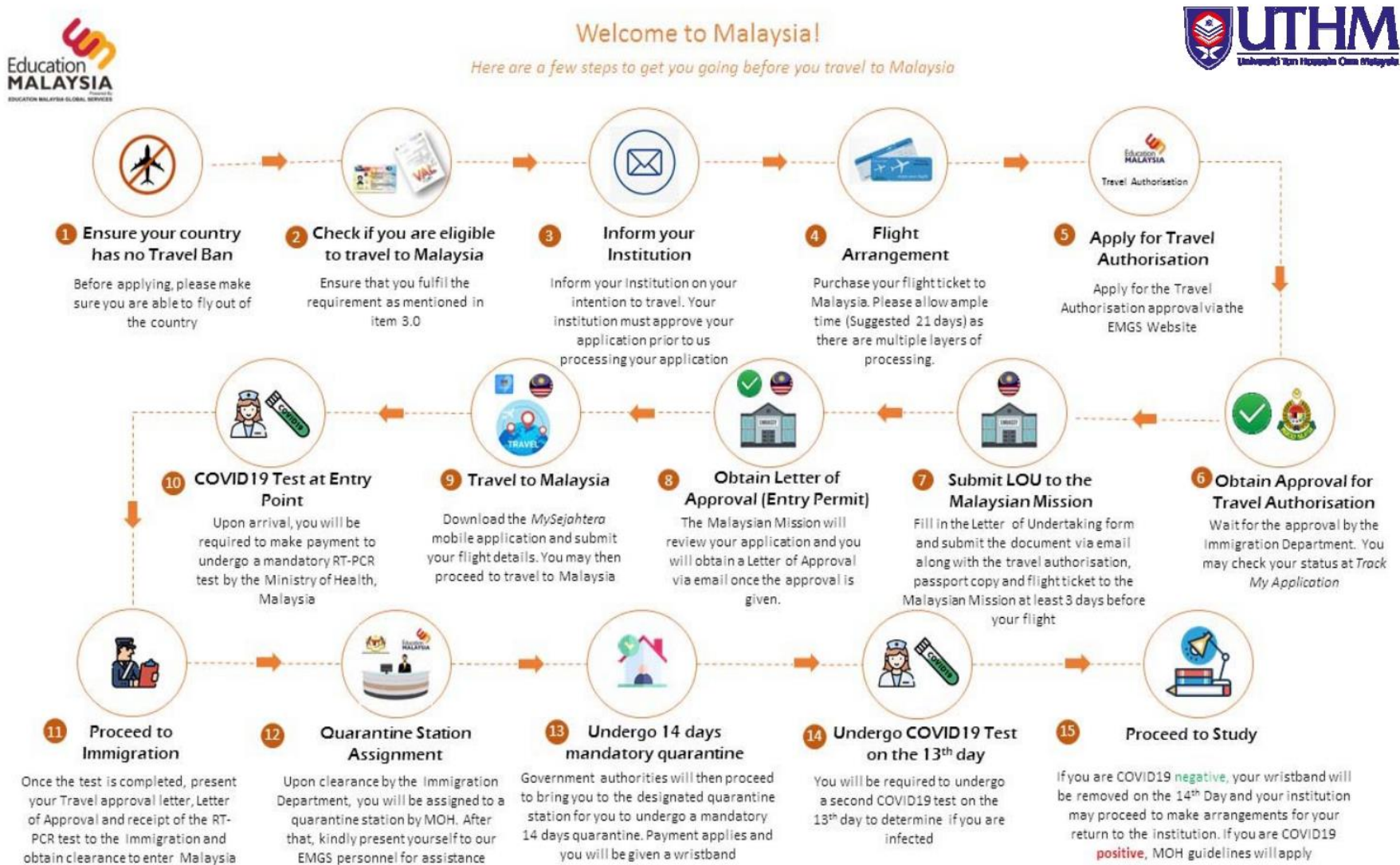
1. Notify your arrival to IO UTHM via email (io@uthm.edu.my)
2. Install mobile apps 'MySejahtera'
3. Online payment for quarantine cost and COVID-19 test. (RM3500 – RM4500)
 - RM2600 (Fixed fee)
 - RM150/day (Quarantine fee)
 - RM120 to RM250 (Covid Test)
4. Undergo COVID-19 swap test at KLIA
 - a) If positive or show symptom, student will be referred to the Hospital with full cost to be borne by the student.
 - b) If negative & no symptom, student will undergo a mandatory quarantine period (from 7 – 14 day).

#3. Post-Arrival

1. Transit to quarantine center by the allocated shuttle service
2. Update IO UTHM via email (io@uthm.edu.my) your expected completion date of quarantine for arrangement of transit to UTHM.
3. Depart from quarantine center by UTHM shuttle

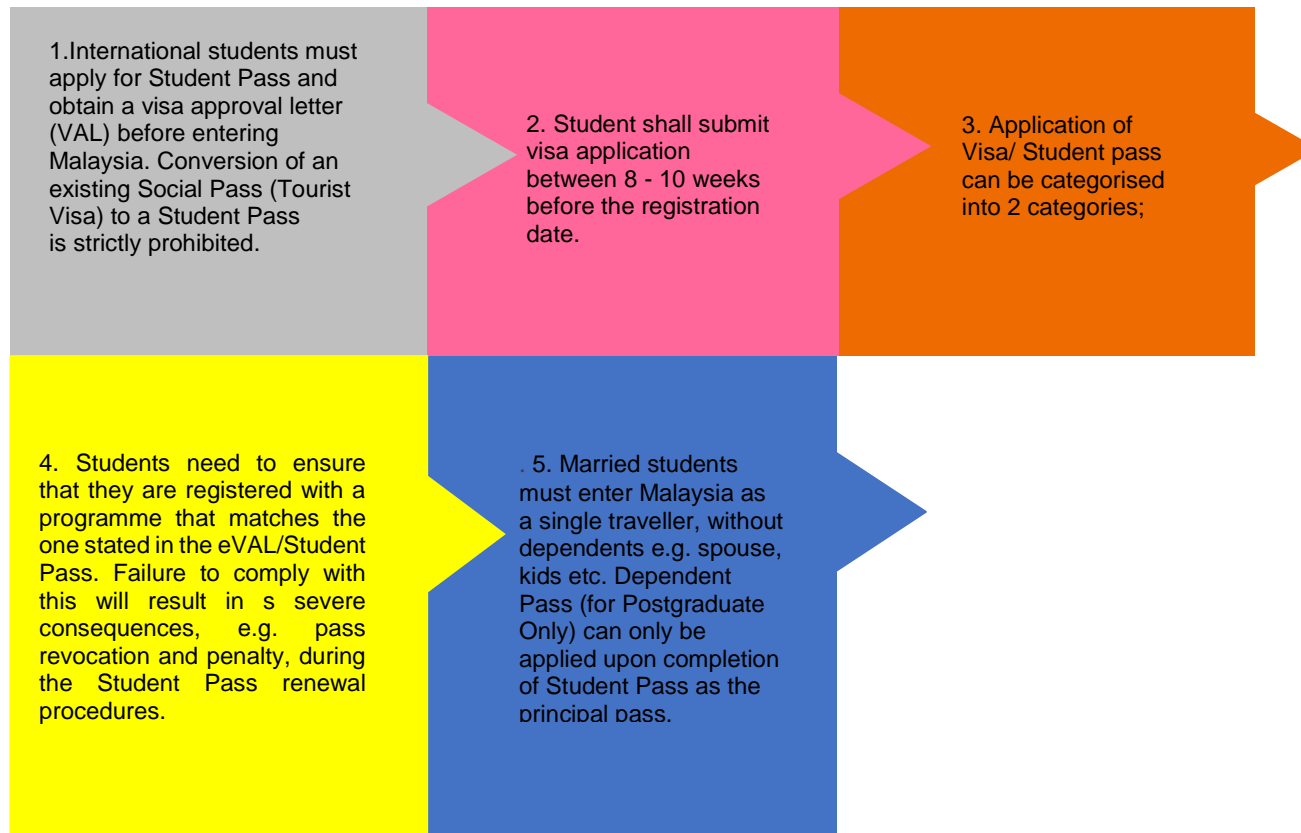

VISA / STUDENT PASS

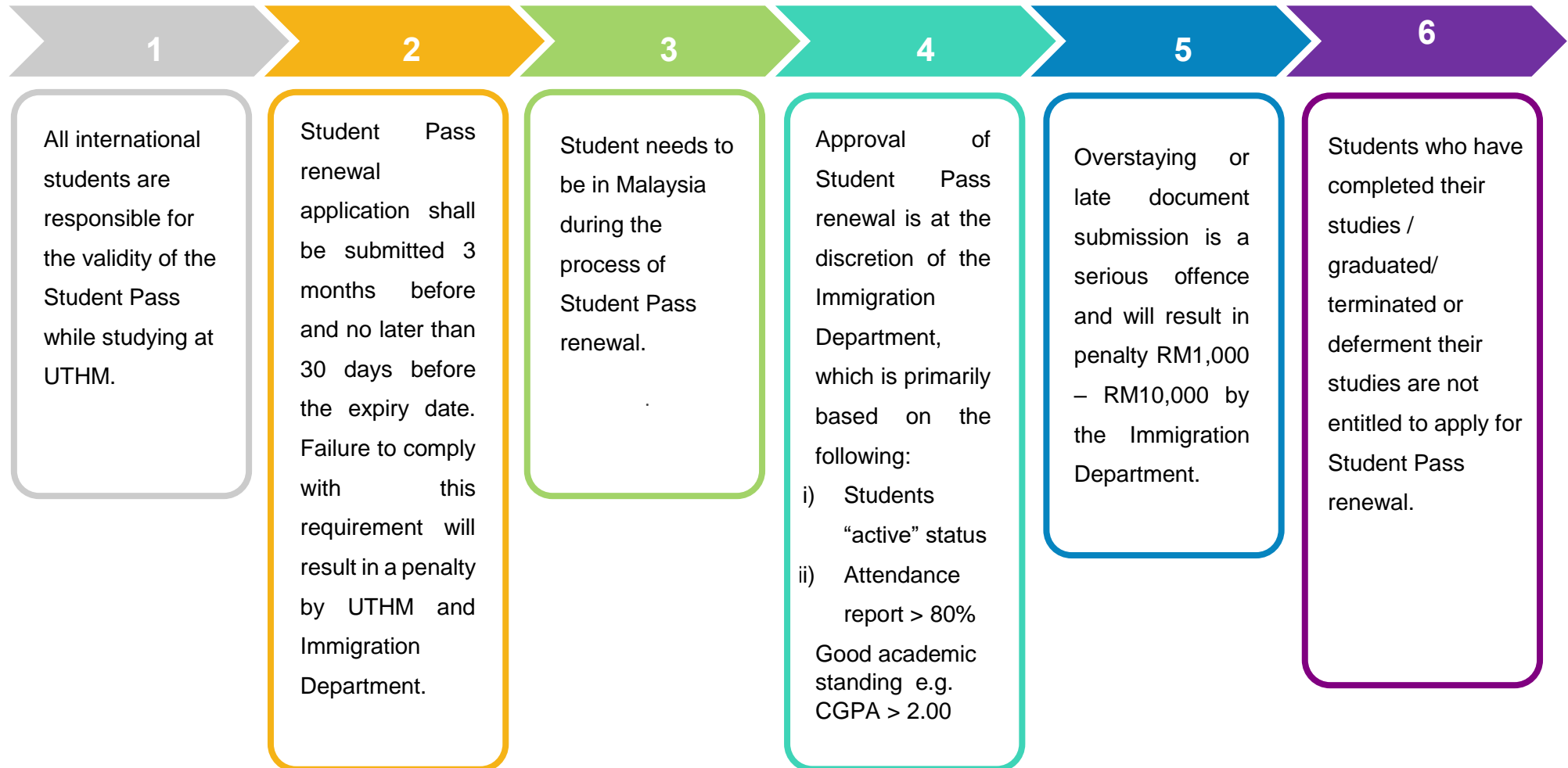

✚ STUDENT PASS RENEWAL



i-KAD & INSURANCE RENEWAL



iKAD and Insurance are issued to all international students, including one-off student pass holders, on a yearly basis. It is compulsory to ensure valid i-KAD and Medical Insurance throughout the study period in Malaysia.



Failure to comply with this requirement will result in revocation of the Student Pass without prior notice.



The renewal application shall be submitted 3 months before and no later than 30 days before the expiry date.

VARIATION AND PROGRESSION

1

International students who wish to apply for Variation and Progression must apply for a new Student Pass through the International Office UTHM. Detailed procedure is available on the IO Website. [\[click here\]](#)

Variation

Changing a program at the same academic level from program A to program B, either within the same or between different faculties / institutions.

Progression:

Progress to the next academic level, e.g. from Bachelor to Master or from Master to PhD

New :

For a valid long-term pass holder (dependent/ employment/ KPI Yemen), progress to the next academic level, e.g. from Bachelor to Master or from Master to PhD.

2

Students must hold a valid pass at the point of submission for the Variation & Progression application. Students without valid passes will not be entertained and may be subject to the Immigration Department's legal procedures.

3

Application of Variation shall be submitted:

Within 30 days from the date of approval to change programme, AND

Within 12 months from the issuance of the existing Student Pass.

4

One-off Student Pass holder can only apply Variation within the same institution. For different institutions, students will be required to exit Malaysia and apply for a new eVAL with the new institution.

5

Approval of Variation / Progression is at the discretion of the Immigration Department.

DEPENDENT PASS (for Postgraduate Only)

1

Dependent Pass is strictly for postgraduate students only and restricted for a spouse and children below 17 years old OR mother OR father. Detailed procedure is available on the IO Website. [\[click here\]](#)

2

Undergraduate students are not entitled to apply for Dependent Pass

3

Passport and supporting documents for Dependent Pass endorsement shall be submitted to IO UTHM within 7 days upon arrival in Malaysia. Late submission could result in severe consequences, e.g. additional charges/ penalties and deportation to the home country.

4

Application for Dependent Pass would require the supporting documentation of a bank statement with a balance of NOT LESS than RM1500 for three (3) consecutive months.

5

Application of Dependent Pass for a new born baby in Malaysia shall be made within 3 months from the date of birth.

6

The student (Principle) shall renew the student pass before submitting a renewal application for the dependents.

VISA / PASS TRANSFER



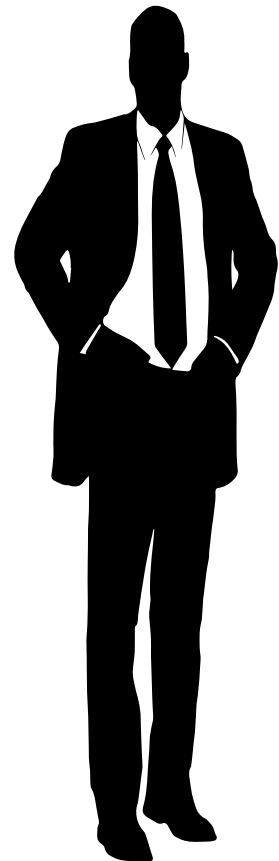
Student who have been issued a NEW passport, shall apply for Pass Transfer to transfer the current valid pass from the old to the new passport. Detail procedure are available in the IO Website. [\[click here\]](#)



Students or dependents may be denied entry into or exit Malaysia if the valid visa is not transferred to the new passport



Should a student change their passport in their home country, the student is required to submit an application for Pass Transfer to the IO UTHM within 3 days of arrival in Malaysia.



CANCELLATION / SHORTEN OF PASS / CHECK OUT MEMO (COM)



It is mandatory for students to cancel student passes and dependent passes (if applicable) for the following circumstances:



The student will be subjected to severe consequences if leaving Malaysia without cancelling the student and dependent passes, such as forfeiture of personal bond and a future travel ban into Malaysia.



A student may also be denied to exit Malaysia at KLIA for failure to comply with the required pass cancellation procedure.

1. Completion of study/ graduation.
2. Withdrawal / termination / deferment study a)
EMGS: via EMGS online platform [[click here](#)]
3. Change the program within faculty or UTHM
4. Change university / institution
5. Change to other type of pass e.g. dependent / employment pass

DEFERMENT OF REGISTRATION

1. Students will be required to defer registration if they fail to obtain VAL upon the registration day.
2. Submit student visa application 10-12 weeks before the registration date, as visa processing may take up to 8 weeks to be approved.

OVERSTAY

1. Overstay is an offence and should be avoided at all costs. It could lead to serious legal consequences:
 - i) Penalty ranging from RM1,000 to RM10,000
 - ii) Jail term of up to 5 years.
 - iii) Immediate deportation to home country
 - iv) Future travel ban into Malaysia
2. Overstay can be avoided by renewing your Student Pass as early as 3 months before the expiry date.

SPECIAL PASS



1

A special pass is a temporary pass issued by the Immigration



2

A student may need to apply for Special Pass if the current valid pass has expired or is less than 7 days before the expiry date.



3

Approval for a Special Pass is at the discretion of the Immigration Department of Malaysia.

INSURANCE

1. It is compulsory for international student to stay protected with a valid insurance policy throughout the period of study in Malaysia. Student must monitor the expiry date of the insurance policy to avoid undesirable implication concerning health.
2. A valid insurance policy is mandatory for Student / Dependent Pass renewal.

PERSONAL BOND PAYMENT & REFUND

1. All international students must pay for Personal Bonds (refundable) as prescribed in Regulation 18 of the Immigration Regulations 1963. The payment shall be made to the Bursary Office UTHM. [\[click here\]](#)
2. Upon completion of study (graduation) or withdrawal, the student may claim for Personal Bond refund from Bursary Office after fulfilling the Visa Cancellation / COM procedure.

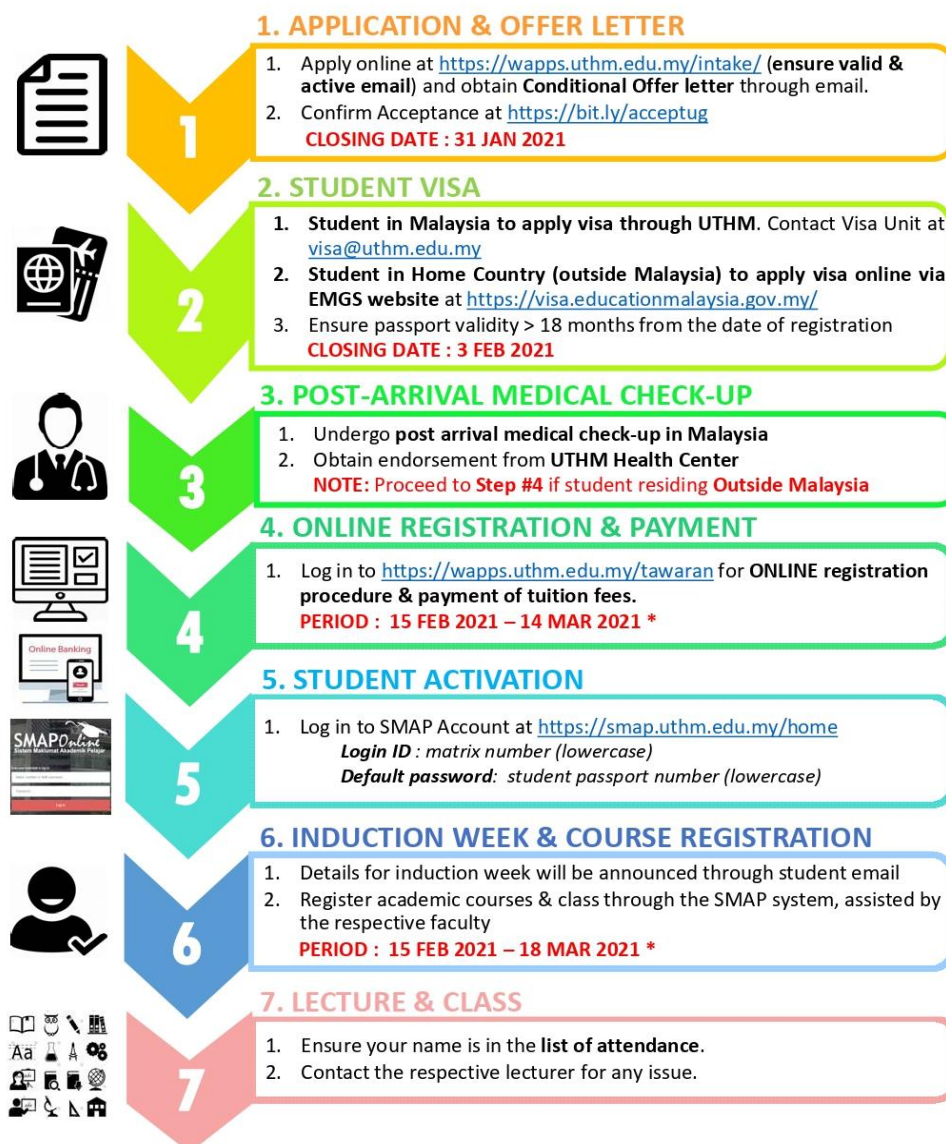

g) Centre for Language Studies (CLS)

Centre for Language Studies (CLS) has been given the vital mandate to contribute to the teaching and learning of languages at the faculty, university and community levels. These include i) offering language courses (English language, international languages, Malay language, ii) language training, iii) language services and consultations, iv) contributions to the language field and research through teaching (language, linguistics and communication), research, writing and seminar organisations at national and international levels. h) Centre for General and Co-Curricular (PPUK)

The Centre for General and Co-Curricular (PPUK) combines the Co-curriculum Centre and the Department of General Studies. PPUK is responsible for managing and conducting courses under General Studies and co-curricular courses. General Studies has 2 departments: the Department of Social Sciences and the Department of Islamic Studies. Both departments offer compulsory university courses at undergraduate and diploma levels. Meanwhile, the Co-curriculum courses cover 10 core areas of entrepreneurship, effort and innovation, liberal literature, public speaking, community service, leadership, skills, sports, culture, and volunteerism.

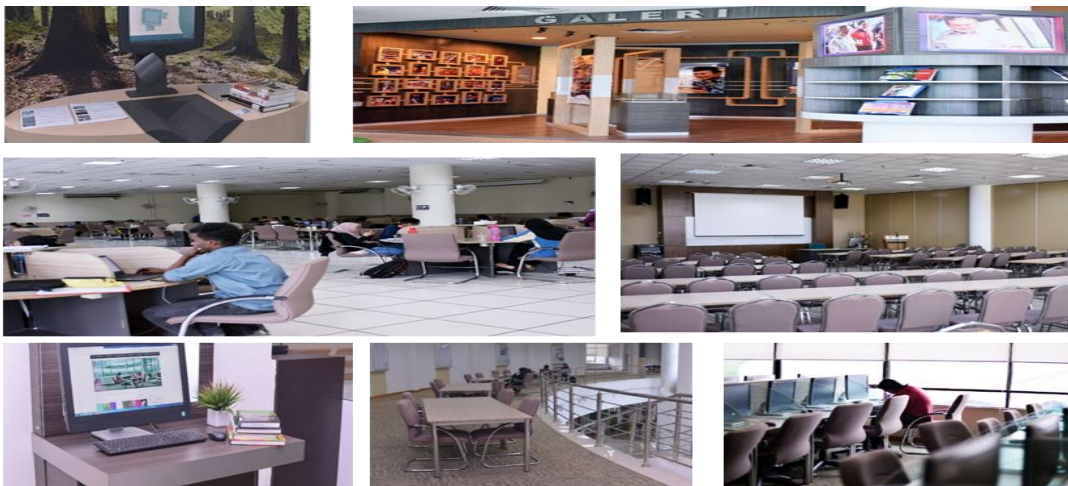

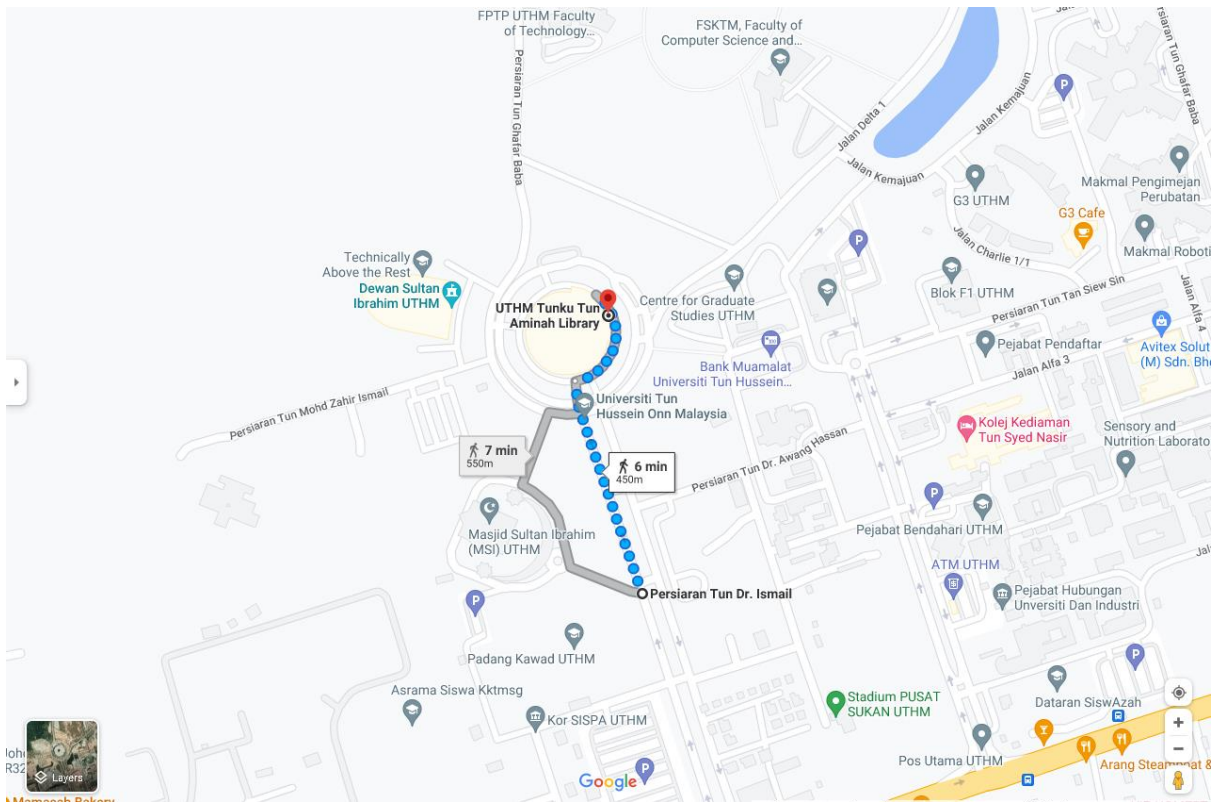

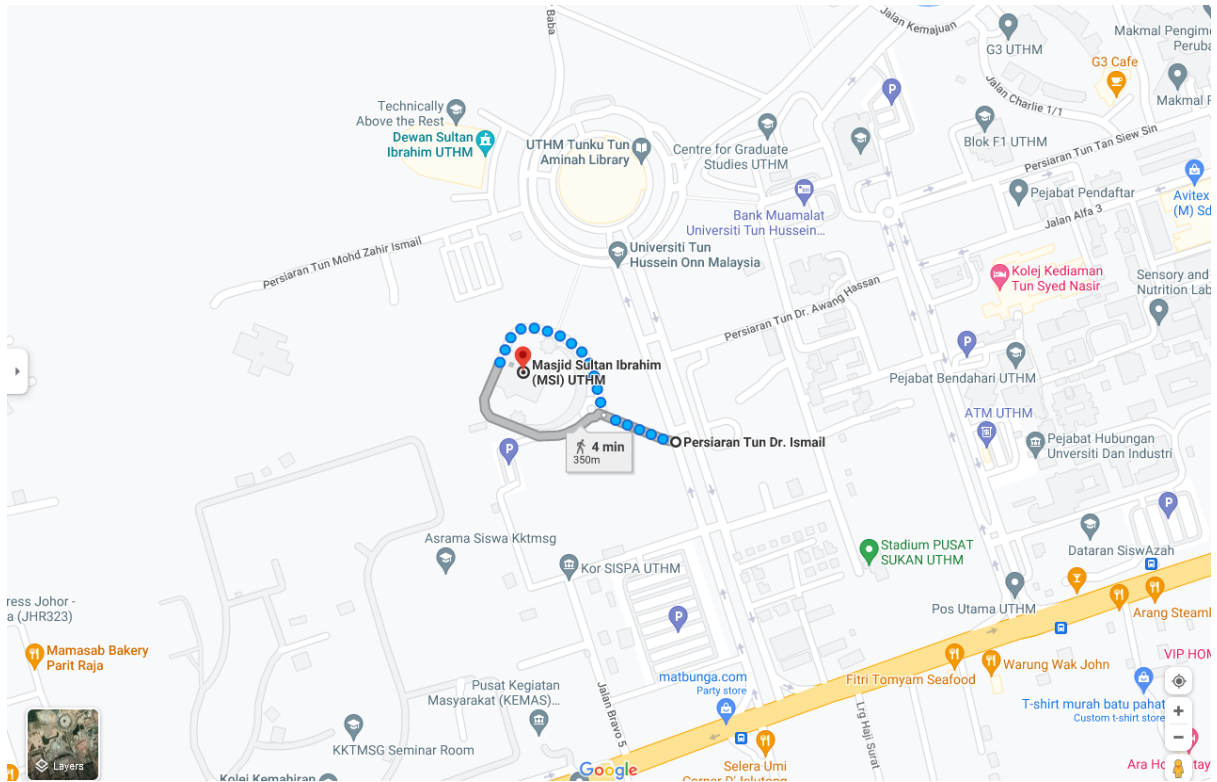

Research Management Centre (RMC)

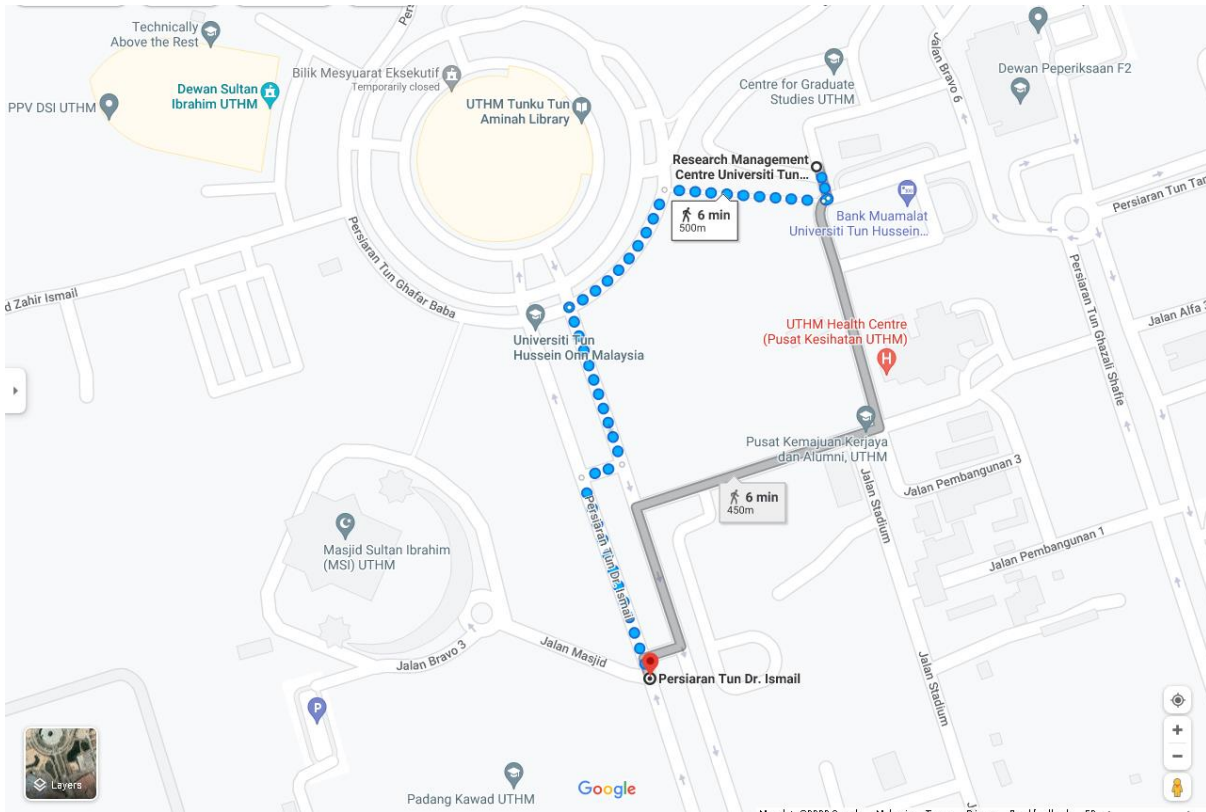

c) Driving in Malaysia

If you hold a valid student pass, you may drive in Malaysia, provided you possess a current international driving license/permit. You must have your license/permit with you when you are driving. If you are going to be mobile in Malaysia, no matter whether you are an experienced driver and have an international drivers' license, you must know the road rules before you attempt to drive. In Malaysia, you drive on the left-hand side of the road, and signboards are normally written in Malay. It is recommended that you take one or two driving lessons in Malaysia before you begin to drive here on your own.

Key road rules:

- ❖ Your vehicle must be registered and has a valid road tax. Driving an unregistered car and/or one without a valid road tax sticker will incur a fine.
- ❖ Obey the speed limit.
- ❖ Drink driving is a serious offence.
- ❖ It is against the law to use your mobile phone when driving unless it is “hands-free”.
- ❖ Drivers and all passengers must wear seat belts.
